


The Cardinal

Colonna Gallery

The Story

The Cardinal Colonna Gallery - also known at the time as the New Gallery - was built in 1730 by the architect Paolo Posi in place of a long corridor, decorated, as some late seventeenth-century guides refer, with the coats of arms of families related to the Colonna. The building is divided into three bodies: two arms and a central rotunda, supported by columns veneered in antique yellow, coming, as it is said, from the Pantheon and until then kept in the basement of the building. The structure was originally intended by Cardinal Jerome II as a library and an increased pictorial and archaeological collection. The Gallery is connected to the garden through two bridges, but the last room, connecting with the Sala della Colonna Bellica, was not yet finished at the time of the cardinal, who died in 1763, while the opposite area which served as a Ballroom for the times of the tenant ambassador of France, it had been decorated in the vault and in the frieze by Annibale Angelini from Perugia. And precisely in this environment, in which at the time a Deposition perhaps by Federico Zuccari could be seen in the background, in the presence of Pius VII, in 1803, the baptism ceremony of the two Savoy twins, Maria Teresa and Maria Anna (future empress of Austria). The event was consigned to memory by two paintings, as a pendant. Over the years the Cardinal Colonna Gallery was used as an archive of the family, which was originally located in the southern canton of the church of SS. Apostoli, in the building later renovated by Niccolò Michetti.

May this evening be one of harmony, inspiration, and grace — an evening where charity, art, and history intertwine to create memories as eternal as the legends we honor.





THE ITALIAN PARALYMPIC COMMITTEE

Who we are

Thanks to the approval of Legislative Decree No. 43 of February 27, 2017, the Italian Paralympic Committee obtained formal recognition as a Public Body for sports practiced by people with disabilities. It maintains its role as a Confederation of Paralympic Sports Federations and Disciplines, both at central and territorial levels, with the task of recognizing any sports organization for people with disabilities throughout the national territory and of ensuring the widest possible dissemination of the Paralympic ideal, as well as the most effective promotion of sports participation among people with disabilities.

Mission

The CIP promotes, regulates, and manages competitive and amateur sports activities for people with disabilities across the national territory, following principles that ensure the right to participate in sports under conditions of equality and equal opportunity.

The CIP's mission includes:

- 1. High-level competition and the preparation of Paralympic athletes across various disciplines, as well as providing the necessary means for the Paralympic Games and for all other national and international Paralympic competitions;
- 2. Promoting the broadest possible participation in sports under conditions of equality and equal opportunity, in order to make the right to sport effective for all individuals across every age group and population sector, at any level, and for any type of disability with particular attention to Paralympic youth sports, supported from preschool age onward, while respecting the competencies of the Regions and the Autonomous Provinces of Trento and Bolzano;



- 3. Supporting all Federations, Associated Disciplines, Promotion Bodies, and recognized Meritorious Associations;
- 4. Promoting and initiating projects for sports participation among people with disabilities throughout the national territory, within the social-health and educational sectors, in compliance with the competencies of the Regions and Autonomous Provinces. The CIP is directly and exclusively responsible for entering into agreements with welfare and/or social security bodies, hospitals, spinal units, and educational institutions, as well as for recognizing sports clubs or other sports entities as Paralympic Sports Initiation Centers (CASP);
- 5. Adopting, also in agreement with the section for supervision and control over doping and for the protection of health in sports activities of the Technical Health Committee established under Article 2 of Presidential Decree No. 44 of March 28, 2013, measures for the prevention and repression of the use of substances that alter the natural physical performance of Paralympic athletes in sports activities;
- 6. Adopting and promoting initiatives against all forms of discrimination and violence in sport.

Dame Shirley Bassey



Dame Shirley Bassey is a name synonymous with glamour, power, and show-stopping talent. With a career that has spanned more than seven decades, she has not only carved her place in the annals of music history but redefined what it means to be a global entertainer. From the stages of Cardiff to the grandest venues in the world, her voice — rich, dramatic, and unforgettable — has resonated with audiences across generations, cultures, and continents.

Born on January 8, 1937, in the vibrant district of Tiger Bay, Cardiff, Shirley Veronica Bassey was the youngest of seven children. Raised in a working-class family, she began performing in local clubs while still in her teens. Her talent was unmistakable from the beginning — a voice that could soar, seduce, and shake a room. She signed her first record deal in the 1950s, and by 1959, she made history with her number one hit "As I Love You," becoming the first Welsh artist to top the UK Singles Chart.

Bassey's ascent was swift and spectacular. Known for her emotional intensity and commanding stage presence, she quickly became a household name. But it was her association with the James Bond film franchise that elevated her to iconic status. Her performance of Goldfinger in 1964 remains one of the most recognizable movie themes of all time. She went on to perform two more Bond themes — Diamonds Are Forever (1971) and Moonraker (1979) — making her the only artist to record multiple songs for the legendary series. These tracks didn't just accompany the films; they defined them, bringing sophistication, mystery, and a touch of danger.

Beyond Bond, Shirley Bassey's discography includes a vast range of songs that reflect her versatility and



emotional range — from torch songs to pop anthems, jazz ballads to disco hits. Her ability to interpret a lyric with both vulnerability and strength has made her performances timeless. She's sold millions of records worldwide and released over 70 albums, with countless chart-topping singles.

Her achievements have been recognized with numerous awards and honors. In 2000, she was appointed a Dame Commander of the Order of the British Empire (DBE) for her services to entertainment. She has also received the first-ever BRIT Award for Best British Female Solo Artist and has performed at some of the world's most prestigious events — including multiple Royal Variety Performances and the opening ceremony of the 1999 Rugby World Cup.

What sets Dame Shirley Bassey apart is not just her extraordinary voice, but her resilience, elegance, and enduring relevance. Through changing musical landscapes and personal challenges, she has continued to reinvent herself while remaining true to the power and authenticity of her artistry. Her story is one of determination, grace, and a fierce commitment to her craft.

Even in recent years, Dame Shirley continues to command stages with the same magnetism she always has. In 2020, she released I Owe It All To You, her final studio album — a heartfelt thank-you to her fans, and a fitting testament to a remarkable career.

Tonight, as we honor Dame Shirley Bassey, we recognize not only a performer of extraordinary talent but a cultural icon who has inspired millions. She broke barriers, defied expectations, and gave the world a voice that is truly one of a kind. Her music, legacy, and spirit will continue to shine for generations to come.

BRAVE HEART & BEST ATHLETE AWARD


Giusy Versace

Paralympic athlete, writer, TV presenter, Senator of the Italian Republic, Giusy Versace was born in Reggio Calabria on May 20th, 1977 and lived in the area until age 20 when work and life took her to London first and to Milan where, for 15 years, she worked in the fashion field as a retail manager. On August 22, 2005, during a business trip, she lost both legs in a car accident, an event that put her whole life at stake without ever representing a surrender.

In 2010 she started running with carbon prostheses, thus becoming the first Italian athlete in history to run with a bilateral amputation. In 7 years she won 11 Italian titles and set several national records in the 100m, 200m, 400m which still bear his name today. With the Fiamme Azzurre sports group, in 2016 she won her first international medals (European Championships: Silver in the 200m and Bronze in the 400m) and in the same year she achieved her greatest goal: participating in the Rio Paralympics, entering the final in the 200m race.

In 2011 she founded the non -profit association "Disabili No Limits" (www.disabilinolimits.org) to help other people with disabilities to obtain high -tech aids and prostheses and promote sport as a means of social inclusion; in the meantime, she has written two books to encourage people to look at disability with better eyes: in 2013 her first autobiography "Con la testa e con il cuore si va ovunque" (With the Head and the Heart You Go Anywhere) and in 2018 her first illustrated book for children "WonderGiusy" (Mondadori), which tells the adventures of a superhero equipped with a pair of winged legs always ready to help others. In 2012 she made her TV debut on Sky Sport, lending her face and voice to experimental projects on Paralympic sport; in 2015 she hosted "Alive - La forza della Vita" on Rete 4 and "La Domenica Sportiva" on Rai2 for the 2015 -16 season; in 2014 she won the 10th edition of "Ballando con le stelle" (Dancing with Stars) broadcast on Rai1; in 2017 she landed on the radio with RTL 102.5 and made her theater debut with the show based on her book "Con la testa e con il cuore si va ovunque" (With the Head and the Heart You Go Anywhere) committing her to a national tour for six months in the theaters of the main Italian cities.

In 2018 she was elected to the italian Parliament to the Chamber of Deputies in the XVIII Legislature, bringing her battles for Sport and young people, for Equal opportunities and for Disabilities to Parliament. In the 2022 political elections, she was elected to the Senate of the Italian Republic in the XIX Legislature. She is a member of the 7th Commission of the Senate (Culture, Sport, Education, Scientific Research and Entertainment) and of the bicameral Commission for Children and Adolescents.



DISABILI NO LIMITS

Giusy Versace is very committed to social causes. In 2011, she founded Disabili No Limits Onlus, a nonprofit organization created to give all people with disabilities a more independent life by donating aids that, to date, are not covered by the National Health System (ASL).

Disabili No Limits raises funds to donate ultralight wheelchairs and carbon fiber prostheses for daily activities and sports, supporting those living in disadvantaged economic circumstances. It organizes events to promote sports and to enable, especially young people, to live their disabilities to the fullest, viewing sport as therapy and a new life opportunity.

Since 2011, Disabili No Limits has donated sports prostheses to over 20 people and donated sports-appropriate chairs and wheelchairs to four sports associations.



GLOBAL ENTEPRENEURSHIP AWARD


Born into a lineage of nation-founding leadership, AlJoharah's path has been shaped by a heritage of public service, equality, education and progressive thought. This legacy of advancing social good, as inspired by her family and her father, continues to guide the principles underpinning her body of work.

Princess AlJoharah pursued her education in Interior Architecture and Engineering at Prince Sultan University, later broadening her strategic perspective through studies in Merging Economics at Harvard University. This multidisciplinary foundation informs a distinctive entrepreneurial philosophy — one that merges creativity with strategic development, placing human and social impact at the heart of it all.

Her business journey began in 2010 with the founding of Arabian Jewel Architects, a company reflecting her belief in the power of design to shape identity, environment and experience. Two years later, she established Atlal AlMajd Holding Company, now a platform for pioneering ventures across multiple sectors. Under its banner, she launched JMH Souk, the first e-commerce marketplace in the Kingdom dedicated to amplifying Saudi's creative talent. Then came Finding Sushi, a popular Japanese restaurant concept that introduced new culinary experiences to Saudi Arabia in 2014.

Princess AlJoharah's work consistently extends beyond the typical commercial realm. In collaboration with the Arab Gulf Programme for Development (AGFUND), she advanced research and practice in early childhood education, contributing to the development of a new educational framework now implemented at Starlight Pre-School. She is also the author of Gonzo's Adventures, a children's book designed to inspire curiosity and creativity at an early age. In 2023, she expanded her portfolio further with a Paris-based fashion initiative, connecting Arab creativity to global industry platforms.

Her entrepreneurial vision is matched by a sincere commitment to philanthropy and civic responsibility. As Vice President of the Talal bin Abdulaziz Foundation, she supports programs focused on women's welfare and children's education. She is co-founder of the Saalima Association for Animal Welfare, an advocate for the Charitable Association for Down Syndrome (DSCA), and a beloved patron of The Magic Drive, a power program focused on confidence building through fashion and self-expression.




AlJoharah's contributions have been widely recognized across the region and internationally. She has been featured in Vogue, Marie Claire Arabia, Emirates Woman, Harper's Bazaar, the landmark publication Under the Abaya and many more. She was honoured at the Alea Global Group Middle East Investment Summit in Dubai and received an honorary degree from the Arab Open University, for her contributions to social development and innovation.

Through her diverse ventures and philanthropic work, Her Royal Highness Princess AlJoharah bint Talal Al Saud embodies the spirit of Vision 2030 — a spirit defined by progress, possibility and a rooted cultural pride. Her dedication has created new pathways for women, children and creatives across Saudi Arabia and the Arab world, strengthening ecosystems of opportunity and contributing to the Kingdom's broader journey of nationwide prosperity.

BLUE PLANET AWARD

Dr. Dionysia-Theodora Avgerinopoulou



Dr. Dionysia-Theodora Avgerinopoulou is the Greek Prime Minister's Envoy for the Ocean and a Member of the Hellenic Parliament. She serves as the Chair of the Parliamentary Committee on Environmental Protection and the Subcommittee of Watercourses. She has served as Vice-President of the Executive Committee of the Inter-Parliamentary Union, Vice Chair of the Global Water Partnership Organization and Chair of the Circle of Mediterranean Parliamentarians for Sustainable Development. She is an attorney-at-law by profession and holds a Doctorate Degree in International Environmental Law.

As the Prime Minister's Envoy. Dr. Avgerinopoulou is one of strongest voices globally for ocean protection globally. She co-leads many ocean initiatives and events in different regions and globally, while she has served as the Coordinator of the 9th Our Ocean Conference (Athens, 2024). In this capacity, Dr. Avgerinopoulou played a pivotal role in bringing together governments and Heads of States, international organizations, scientists, civil society, and the private sector to support a strong voice for the ocean! Under her coordination, the Conference achieved an unprecedented USD 11.3 billion in new commitments for ocean action. She also guided Greece's 21 national commitments, including the establishment of two new Greek National Marine Parks and initiatives for marine biodiversity protection, ocean and port decarbonization, marine litter reduction, climate protection, and sustainable blue economy development.



Dr. Avgerinopoulou serves as the Chairperson of the Special Permanent Parliamentary Committee on Environmental Protection and the Subcommittee of the Watercourses of the Hellenic Parliament. Under this capacity, she has co-chaired the debates on several environmental and climate strategies, policies and legislation, including the first Climate Law of Greece, the Law establishing the first Greek Agency on Nature, Environment and Climate Change, and the National Strategy on Biodiversity and the National Plan for the Energy and Climate. She also participates at the parliamentary and governmental delegations of the most important environmental and climate meetings, such as UNFCCC COPs, UNEAs, and UN HLPPs, helping to mainstream, among others, the gender and climate agenda. Dionysia's innovative work focuses on the one hand on fostering science, technology and innovation for the solution of environmental and climate issues, and on the other hand on climate finance. For instance, she is the first politician in Greece to introduce the climate finance and the ESG concept in the public debate. She works constantly on issues, such as: climate-water-food-energy nexus; decarbonization and just transition; greening of the shipping sector; development of alternative fuels for transportation; prevention and response to natural and anthropogenic emergencies; biodiversity protection; reforestation; knowledge management; environmental and climate dimensions of agriculture, including both mitigation and adaptation; sustainable tourism; the efficient waste management and the development of a circular economy; empowerment of the enforcement mechanisms of Environmental Law; support of innovative technologies for earth applications, including space technologies and DAC innovations; renewable energy sources; and ocean and climate nexus.

Dionysia has held several other important parliamentary positions on the international level. For instance, she is currently the Vice-President of the Inter-Parliamentary Union representing the Twelve Plus Group, while she has also served as the first Chairperson of the Standing Committee for the UN Affairs of the Inter-Parliamentary Union, in Geneva, Switzerland. Under this capacity, she had joined the team for the deliberations between the IPU and the UN regarding the adoption of the SDGs. Dionysia participates in a

series of other parliamentary networks on climate and the environment, including the Climate Parliament and the Network of Women Ministers and Leaders for the Environment.

On the regional level, Dr. Avgerinopoulou also serves as the Chairperson of the Circle of the Mediterranean Parliamentarians on Sustainable Development (COMPSUD). Leading a dynamic network of Parliamentarians, members of the Environment Committees of twenty-six countries around the Mediterranean Sea, Dionysia-Theodora placed particular emphasis on efforts for the de-pollution of the Mediterranean, the combat against marine litter, and especially micro-plastics; she actively promoted sustainable education, north – south and south-sough cooperation and technology transfer, while she raised awareness on common issues that the Mediterranean countries share, such as the slow onset events due to climate change, including coastal erosion and natural disasters, most prominently wildfires. Her efforts in the Mediterranean Region were also focused on the refugee crisis, where she developed a project along with COMPSUD, in order to mitigate the environmental impacts of the refugee issue, facilitate the sustainable use of natural resources, and offer further humanitarian assistance.

She has also served as the Vice-Chair for the Mediterranean Commission on Sustainable Development of UNEP/MAP. As Vice-Chair, she has reviewed the Mid-Term Strategy of UNEP/MAP for the protection of the Marine Environment and the Coastal Region of the Mediterranean; reviewed sustainable development projects within the Mediterranean Region, including projects on biodiversity; reviewed reports on the Good Environmental Status of the Mediterranean; provided assistance to the Contracting Parties in meeting their obligations under Articles 4 and 10 of the Barcelona Convention, and under the "Protocol concerning Specially Protected Areas and Biological Diversity in the Mediterranean", and implementing the "Strategic Action Programme for the Conservation of Biological Diversity in the Mediterranean Region".

In addition, she stands at the forefront for scaling up the climate ambition in the Mediterranean region, including the acceleration of the use of renewable sources of energy, while she is working on promoting sustainable and smart cities in the region, as well as the "green ports" and the "GR-ECO islands", a flagship initiative led by Greece as part of the NDCs of the country. She was also elected as the regional representative and then as the Vice-Chair of the Steering Committee of the Global Water Partnership Organization (GWPO) in Stockholm, Sweden. As the Vice-Chair, Dionysia promoted further the concept of the integrated water resources management, while she worked along with the representatives of the UN Water, the World Bank, and the founding States and sponsors of GWPO. She co-led the global dialogue on the valuation of water, and she mainstreamed even further the climate dimension in the water management principles, techniques and projects of the GWPO. She supported the participation of Youth and Women on the Climate and Water agenda of GWPO and the human rights agenda regarding to access to healthy and adequate water, including the gender dimension.

Dr. Avgerinopoulou was, also, elected as the Head of Water of the Energy and Environment Committee of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) in Paris, France, while she was appointed as Head of the Environment and Energy Commission of the International Chamber of Commerce in Greece. In these capacities, Dionysia participated in a series of UNFCCC COPs and SBs meetings and contributed to shaping the positions of the ICC regarding energy and environmental issues that relate to the business community worldwide, such as the Global Compact for the Environment, the Just Transition Framework and a Global Constitution of the Environment.

Dionysia-Theodora is an attorney-at-law by profession. She has previously worked, among others, at the Legal Service of the European Commission in Brussels, Belgium, the Permanent Mission of the European Union at the United Nations in New York, U.S.A., the Center on Environmental and Land Use Law of the



New York University School of Law in New York, the Yale Center for Environmental Law and Policy and the Yale Law School in New Haven, C.T., U.S.A.

Dionysia received a first Degree in Law (LL.B.) from the Faculty of Law of the National and Kapodestrian University of Athens, Greece, with Hons., and an LL.M. in International Legal Studies from Georgetown University Law Center in Washington, D.C. with Distinction. She also holds a Doctorate Degree in International Environmental Law (J.S.D.) from Columbia University School of Law in New York, NY., focusing on the integration of science, including climate science, in international lawmaking processes and the Global Environmental Governance, including climate governance and the Global Environmental Administrative Law. Dionysia is the author of several academic articles and a book on International and European Environmental Law. She teaches Public International Law, International Environmental Law, European Environmental Law, Law of Sustainable Development, Climate Change Law and Energy Law.

Dr. Avgerinopoulou has been elected as a Young Global Leader of the World Economic Forum for her leadership in environmental protection. She has received the "Green Star" Award by UNEP/OCHA/Green Cross International for her efforts in preventing and responding to environmental emergencies. She was also selected among the "40Under40" of the EU. She also received a Special Congressional Recognition for her "outstanding efforts and invaluable contributions on behalf of Hellenic Students and the environment" and the Global Citizenship Award for Leadership in Assisting Humanity by Orphans International Worldwide in 2010. Finally, she is the recipient of the international Goddess Artemis Award by the Euro-American Women's Council for her contribution to transatlantic cooperation between the U.S. and the EU on environmental and climate change issues, as well as the Agni Vlavianos Award by the Club of Rome – Hellenic Chapter for her overall contribution to global environmental affairs.

She speaks Greek (modern and ancient), English, French, German, and Spanish. She is the mother of one young boy.




Bruno Gianesi



Friederike Krum - Mezzo-Soprano - MYTHOS AWARD WINNER 2025

Friederike Krum is an award-winning German mezzo-soprano based in London, celebrated for her vocal versatility and captivating stage presence. Renowned for her expansive repertoire spanning classical, operatic, and contemporary styles such as musical, American songbook and jazz, she has performed for television audiences of millions and on some of the world's most iconic stages alongside leading orchestras.

Her distinguished career includes performances alongside legendary artists such as Plácido Domingo, José Carreras, Montserrat Caballé, Sir Rod Stewart, Robbie Williams and Tony Bennett. With platinum selling tenor Russell Watson she performed at the Royal Albert Hall launching their charity duet they recorded in aid of the Chelsea Pensioner Veterans to critical acclaim and standing ovations.



Her Christmas duet, Have Yourself A Merry Little Christmas, topped the German Classical Charts at No.1.

Friederike received her formal training at the prestigious 'Musikhochschule für Musik und Theater', Hamburg and studied privately with the legendary soprano Dame Elisabeth Schwarzkopf. In addition, she trained at the 'Stage School of Music, Dance & Drama' in Hamburg with Noel Turner. Her career has been the subject of several television documentaries, and she is a frequent guest on TV for interviews such as GBNews, TalkTv, German ZDF and NDR. German RTL TV featured her in their recent 2025 TV series 'Superstadt' to document her career and life in London.

Her Royal Albert Hall solo debut in 2018 was the first of many, returning for subsequent performances. She sang alongside Westend stars Ruthie Henshall, Mazz Murray, Ben Forster, Ramin Karimloo, John Owen-Jones and Marisha Wallace accompanied by the Royal Philharmonic and BBC Orchestra amongst others. She worked with Westend choreographer Steven Mear and the legendary Mike Dixon whom she worked with when playing the lead role in a German version of 'Beauty & The Beats'. Mike was so impressed that even decades later he mentioned her performance in his autobiography alongside stars such as Dame Shirley Bassey.

A frequent performer for both British and German Armed Forces, she has been invited to sing at official events attended by dignitaries including Chancellor Angela Merkel and Dr. Ursula von der Leyen, President of the European Commission. In 2014, she joined Dr. von der Leyen on a Christmas visit to NATO camp in Afghanistan, performing for the troops. In 2018, she sang at the Berlin Cathedral for the Centenary Memorial Concert for the German Ministry of Defence.



Friederike has performed in the presence of HM King Charles III and HRH The Princess Royal. In recognition of her contributions and brilliant fundraising skills, she was appointed the inaugural Ambassador of the Chelsea Pensioners' Scarlets Appeal in 2018 and named an official Ambassador of the Irish Guards Charity in 2023. In 2024, she was appointed Ambassador for Grange Park Opera in Surrey and Ambassador of SAFA The Armed Forces Charity.

A passionate advocate for cross-cultural and musical dialogue, Friederike appeared on GB News with Nigel Farage during the Vigil of the Princes, discussing royal music traditions and Anglo-German relations. On the day of the King's Coronation, she was invited to perform the UK National Anthem on national television.

Together with James Pearson, Artistic Director of Ronnie Scott's Jazz Club, she released her Gershwin tribute album Somebody Loves Me – The Songs of Gershwin, which received widespread acclaim from SCALA Radio and a personal letter of praise from the late HM Queen Elizabeth II. Her Christmas duet 'Have Yourself a Merry Little Christmas', which she released with actor Bruno Maccallini made No 1 in the German Classic charts.

I want to thank the President of the Maria Callas Monaco Gala & Awards, the wonderful Ioanna Efthimiou, for bestowing me with this incredible honour.

Maria Callas was without doubt the most extraordinary & divine soprano of all times.

Her voice touches me each time I hear a recording as she sang the arias in a way which made them come alive as if one was in the theatre watching her live. The way she poured her soul and heart into the emotional portrayal of each role was unparalleled. She was not acting-she was living the character she sang. Her ability of losing herself completely in each role she sang is what made her 'La Divina'

THE BEL CANTO ARTIST AWARD Placido Domingo Jr.



Born in Mexico City, son of the tenor and philanthropist Placido Domingo.

Immersed from an early age in the opera world, he develops a passion for music. In his career, he has composed songs for famous artists like Michael Bolton, Riccardo Cocciante, Sarah Brightman, José Carreras, Luciano Pavarotti, Leona Mitchell, Diana Ross, Alejandro Fernández, Tony Bennett and Placido Domingo.

He participates in the album "Infinite Love" (published in 2009) as an executive producer, composer and singer. The album, which contains the poems of John Paul II interpreted by his father, stands on Billboard's Top Classical Crossover Album.

In 2009 he composed the official anthem of the prestigious Operalia international Opera competition. Parallel to his work as a composer and record producer, in 2010 he made his debut as a performer, in collaboration with Juan Cristobal Losada, Prize Winner Producer / Engineer Grammy Awards.

In 2017 he released his first LP entitled "Latidos" which contains new versions in Spanish and English of classic '50s and' 60s, such as Bésame Mucho, Solamente Una Vez, Sabor a Mi, Perfidia, Frenesí.

It is a classical crossover album with influences from all over America, with the participation, among others, by artists such as Plácido Domingo, José Feliciano, Ana Isabelle, and Arturo Sandoval.

As of 2010 he has increased his singing activities around the world, both with his father Placido Domingo and as a soloist. Among his concerts: Mexico, Uruguay, Armenia, Slovakia, Lithuania, Latvia, Serbia, United States, China, Germany, Spain, Poland, Romania, Austria, Ireland, Italy, Honduras, Guatemala, Kazakhstan, Brazil, Russia, Ukraine, Colombia, San Salvador.

In 2014 he participated in the iTunes Festival in London. In 2016 he is engaged in a long tour in Germany with the "Sinatra German" Götz Alsmann and SWR Band.

He participated in several concerts in Spain, as part of "The Musicals" project with the Philharmonic Orquesta y Coro of Madrid, conducted by Pascual Osa.

In 2016 he took part in the great concert "Placido en el Alma" at the Santiago Bernabeu Stadium in Madrid, attended by 65,000 people.

In December of 2016 he took part in a special "reunion" in the city of Zamora in Spain, sharing the stage with Montse and Cecilia, daughters of the famous singers Montserrat Caballé and Teresa Berganza. On December 14th he performs at the XXII edition of the Jose Carreras Gala broadcast live on German television Sat Gold 1.

In May 2017 he presented at the Auditorium Parco della Musica in Rome a preview of "Volver - Anima Tango", a music and dance show inspired by the atmospheres of Argentine tango, from which the homonymous album was also born. Also, in 2017 he was engaged in a long tour in Brazil.

In November 2017 he performed a solo concert at the St. Petersburg Philharmonic.

In 2018 he produced and premiered his musical "Vlad" in Spain.

Starting from July 2019 he began the collaboration with the Hungarian talent show "Virtuosos", a competition for young virtuosos in the field of singing and classical music, composing the main theme of the competition and participating in the role of mentor and host.

In September 2019 he performed at the Moscow International House of Music, together with soprano Irina Polivanova, under the conduction of Maestro Dennis Vlasenko.

In 2019, 2020 and 2021 he participated in the show "Tango Passport" together with the Polish soprano Alicja Węgorzewska at the Opera Kameralna in Warsaw.

Currently engaged in the production of his next discographic work, based on the French repertoire.

Anastasia Valavanidi

Anastasia Valavanidi – The Greek Voice That Travels the World

At just fifteen, Anastasia Valavanidi has already achieved what many dream of — turning her voice into a bridge between people and cultures. A true artist at heart, she sees music not only as art, but as a way to make the world brighter and kinder.

From early childhood, Anastasia showed remarkable sensitivity and determination. Between 2018 and 2024, she took part in fourteen international competitions, earning distinctions in singing, presentation, and visual arts, proudly representing Greece.

A Presenter with Purpose

In 2021, Anastasia was selected among 136 young participants worldwide as the main presenter of an 11.5-hour international online marathon. Filming in Thessaloniki and Halkidiki, she created thematic videos that celebrated Greece's light, sea, and culture. She also produced

twelve short artistic segments, blending music, painting, and direction, including a memorable masterclass on clothing painting for children.

That same year, her televised interviews with Spyros Lambros and Zina Koutselini revealed a maturity beyond her age, while she later hosted an international online Gala Concert uniting young voices from around the globe.

From the Herodeion to Cannes

Anastasia made her theatrical debut at the Herodes Atticus Theatre in Zacharias Rochas' Karagiozis and the Great Revolution, honoring 200 years since the Greek Revolution. At the same time, she joined Giannis Zouganelis in the "IDANIKA" campaign for children with Down syndrome, using art to promote inclusion and empathy.



Beyond performing, she studies piano, traditional Greek and Byzantine music, and has presented her paintings in exhibitions in Greece and abroad.

A Voice Beyond Borders

By 2023, Anastasia's voice had already reached international audiences: she performed at a charity event during the Cannes Film Festival, joined Spain's Duet with the Stars project, and took part in Greek initiatives promoting Hope, Love, and Peace. Her impact was recognized by the World Festivals Organization (WAF), which named her an "Emerging Young Artist with a Bright Future."

Honored in Monaco

In 2025, she was honored at the Maria Callas Monaco Awards, receiving a commendation from Prince Albert II of Monaco. That same year, she appeared in The Stories of Grandpa Aristophanes with the Theatre of Artists with Disabilities and Giannis Zouganelis, performing at the Royal Theatre and Thes-

saloniki Concert Hall — a production celebrating diversity and equality.

Leader and Innovator

Beyond the stage, Anastasia is an active student and athlete, distinguished in volleyball and basketball, and serves as Vice President of her Student Council. Through a school project, she helped design a web app for refugees and newcomers to Thessaloniki, offering practical information on housing, healthcare, and education — a project that mirrors her belief in compassion through action.

Art as Giving

Her artistic journey is inseparable from her philanthropic mission. Through international initiatives supporting people with disabilities and children in need, she proves that art can heal and unite.

A Bright Ambassador of Greece

With maturity, authenticity, and vision, Anastasia Valavanidi stands as one of the most promising young voices of her generation. From Thessaloniki to Monaco, from Cannes to countless hearts, she carries the spirit of Greece — reminding us that when talent meets kindness and purpose, it can truly transform lives-and perhaps, the world itself.

BEST GENTLEMAN MUSIC ARTIST AWARD


Maurits Drenth

Winner of the Maria Callas best male artist of the year award 2025

Born in the Netherlands, Maurits Drenth is an emerging vocalist whose artistry unites classical refinement with the emotional power of contemporary performance. Based between Monaco and the Netherlands, he has quickly established himself as one of the most promising young singers, recognized for his versatile voice, commanding stage presence, and deep musical sensibility.

From an early age, Drenth displayed an exceptional affinity for music. His early studies included the works of Maria Callas and Luciano Pavarotti, later expanding to modern icons suchas Whitney Houston, Adele, and Frank Sinatra. This wide foundation gave him a distinctive vocal style, technically disciplined yet emotionally unrestrained and prepared him for the diverse performance opportunities that would define his young career.

Drenth's career gained national attention in 2023 when he reached the semifinals of Holland's Got Talent. His performances on the televised competition showcased his dynamic vocal range and stage charisma, earning him recognition from audiences and professionals alike. The experience also marked his first exposure to large-scale production environments, where he learned to translate emotional nuance into television performance, a skill that would later serve him in international venues. By 2024, Drenth had transitioned from



And had one of the greatest honours of his career when he was asked to sing at the Fight Aids Monaco memorial service in November 2024 at the Oceanographic Museum, held under the high patronage of Princess Stéphanie of Monaco.

The year 2025 marked a period of extraordinary artistic expansion. In April, Drenth received the Jury Prize at the Golden Voices competition in Cannes. The following month, he performed at the 78th Cannes Film Festival, appearing at the legendary Carlton Hotel in a charity gala dedicated to the memory of Princess Grace of Monaco. His ability to merge elegance, restraint, and emotion made him a standout among performers and a sought-after voice for international events.

Alongside his musical career, Maurits Drenth is pursuing higher education at the International University of Monaco, where he began studies in 2024. He combines his academic path with his artistic journey, destined to leave a lasting impression on the world of music.



his unlimited hunger for knowledge in order to convey, through his work, the fruit of his discoveries. Without ever seeking, however, either consensus or, at times, sharing.

Active in the artistic field since 1999, between 2004 and 2009 he sold several hundred Works in different cities of the World. He is present in several important Roman homes as well as prominent residences in: London Chelsea, Monte Carlo, Paris, Barcelona, Marbella, Malaga, Toulouse, Lanzarote, Istanbul, New York, Miami, Washington, San Francisco, and Los Angeles; and also in several accommodations with significant collections. He has had major solo exhibitions at the Museo del Vittoriano in Rome, City Hall in



Flissingen, the Italian Cultural Center in Istanbul, and the Cultural Institute in Atlanta, Georgia, among others. He has been invited to some important international fairs such as New York Art Show in 2004, Cow Parade in Florence in 2005 and Rome in 2010, IED in Rome in 2010, Open 8 2005 and Open 10 2007 (International Exhibition of Sculpture and Installations) in Venice, during which he won the Prize for the best work among more than 47 International Artists. Articles about him have appeared in Art USA, Sculture International, on the front page of the Washington Times and Roma Contemporanea. He is the author (the only experience in the world) of interventions directly on original Classical Works of significant importance such as Polidoro da Caravaggio's 1515 Altarpiece and Ferdinando Galli Bibbiena's canvas, 1700. He has obtained important artistic assignments, including the role of manager of the Capitoline Cultural Superintendency of Rome and the delegation of contemporary Art and Architecture from January 2011 to July 2013 within the Department of Culture and the Historic Center of Rome. He currently has a stock consisting of approximately 300 Cartoons, 50 Wooden Doors, 200 Paper Strips, 150 Miscellaneous Papers, 200 Nudes, 300 Miscellaneous Works, 1,000 sketches on block, 5,000 Retouched Photos, 200 various elaborations, charcoal drawings, "Erotic Notebooks" and Painted Books. As part of his own research, he has developed an activity tending to the economic exploitation of his talent through what is called Appropriation Art (both in the technological and material spheres) and design









applied to Art, exploiting his studies in the field of Sensitive Architecture, for which Architect Helio Piñon, Chair of Sensitive Architecture at the Faculty of Barcelona, has described him as the top talent in the international field.

Makis Koulianos is an artist who was born in 1985 in Brooklyn, New York and raised in Litochoro, Pierias Greece.



His art takes a style of the neo-baroque, neo-classical and depicts consciousness through enlightenment and conscious choices.


Makis Koulianos' paintings recognize the sensitivity of the soul through the esoteric exploring, combing chiaroscuro and tenebrism.
